The event aims to nurture, build, and celebrate the greater visual and performing local arts community. There will also be small-scale performing arts scattered throughout the area, such as musicians and circus acts, as well as a very generously-sized Kid-zone with activities for all ages. ## World Music Fest

Saturday, October 17<sup>th</sup>

World Music Fest is an annual event featuring music and art from around the globe with an emphasis on showcasing regional artists – a celebration of culture and diversity. Through the universal language of music and art, this annual event builds bridges within the community, provides a platform for excellent local musicians and artists, and shows that there is a whole world within the place that we call home. World Music Fest has previously been held in Southgate House in Newport, KY. It will involve seven venues within the Arts District, including Baker Hunt, AEC, MarX Gallery, StepNOut Studio, The Avenue, Madison Theater and Leapin Lizzard Gallaeary. The festival will be open to all ages. World Music Fest is organized by Play it Forward, a 501c3 nonprofit organization, with support from the City of Covington. Expected Attendance: 3,000-5,000 people.



## Screen Test

Sunday, October 25<sup>th</sup>

Covington's First Film Festival! Now more than ever, filmmakers are utilizing the web to produce their films and this event will bring Covington and our region to the twenty-first century of film making. Hosted by Covington-based production companies Big Fat Brain and Barking Fish, members of the Covington Film Festival Committee will create Film Zero that provides a foundation for the project. Filmmakers, musicians, artist and general audiences would then help to make this project come to life around the web through other films, music, blogs, social media applications, documentary films and more. The best elements of the experience, including the original film, the documentary, will be showcased at the Carnegie Center of the Arts along with other incentive events with the filmmakers and participants in and around Covington. This event requires participation from a variety of groups and will be the first year of an annual Covington Film Festival. Expected Attendance: 500-1000
